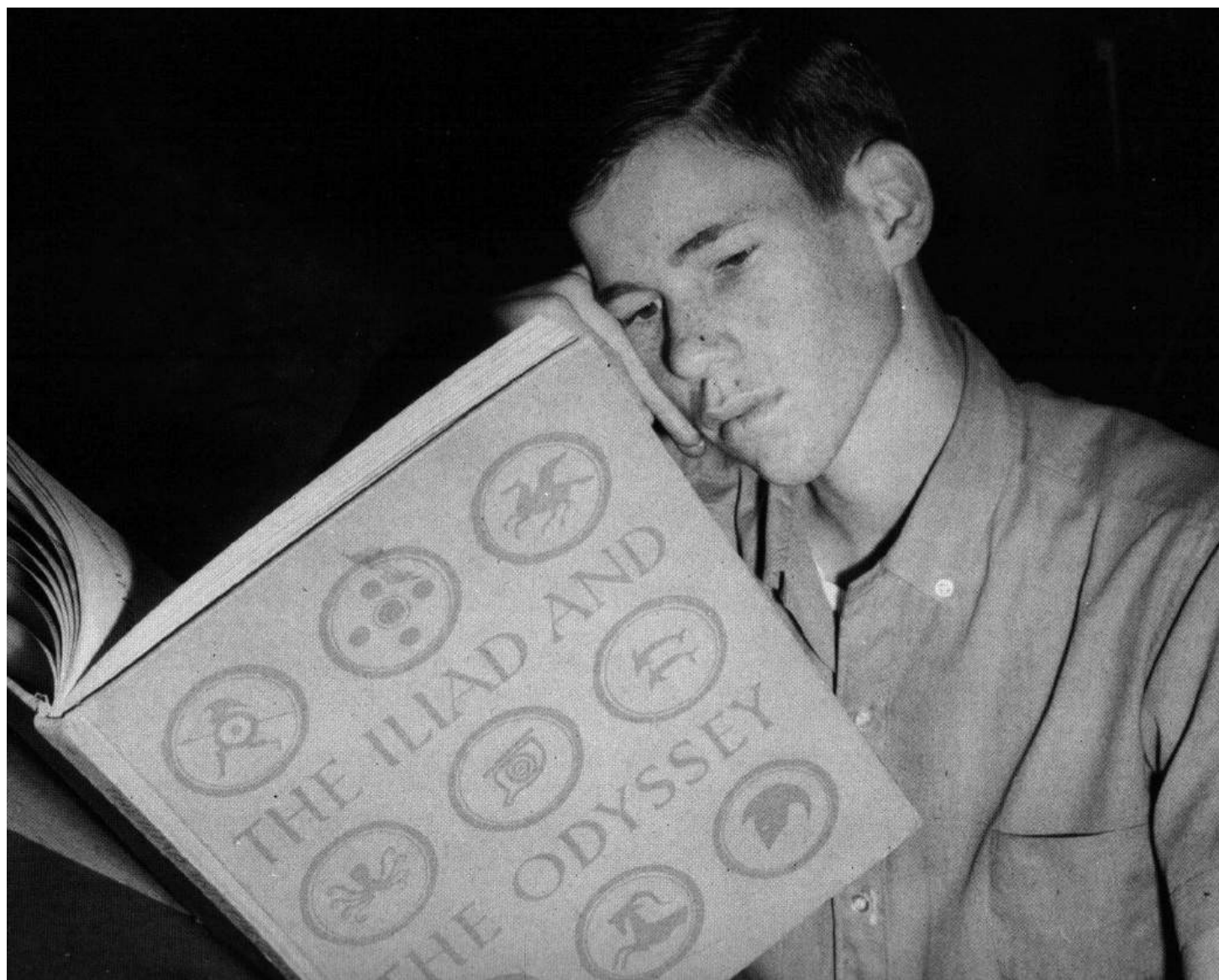




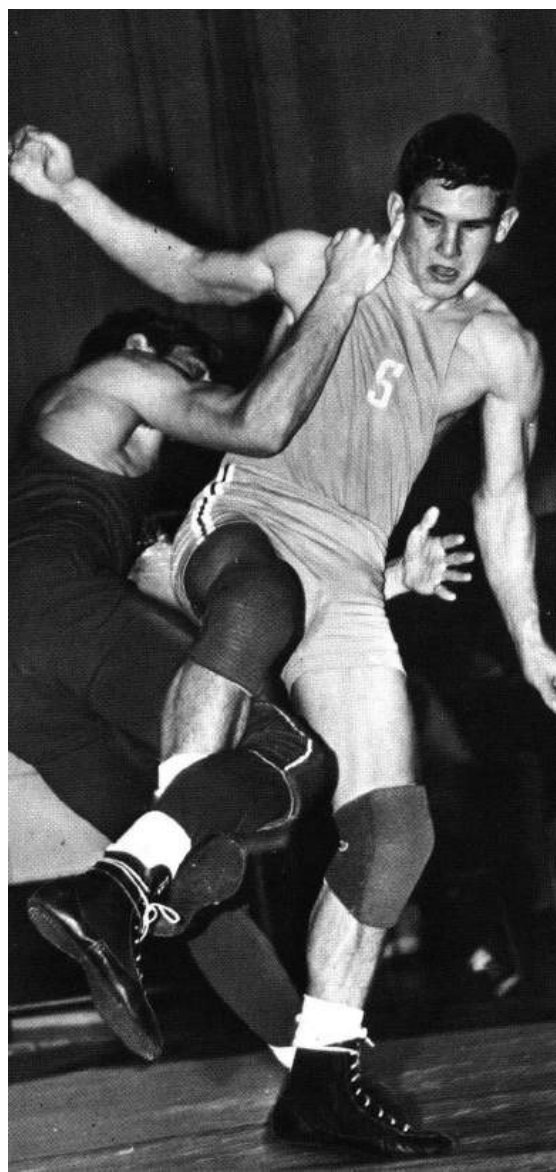


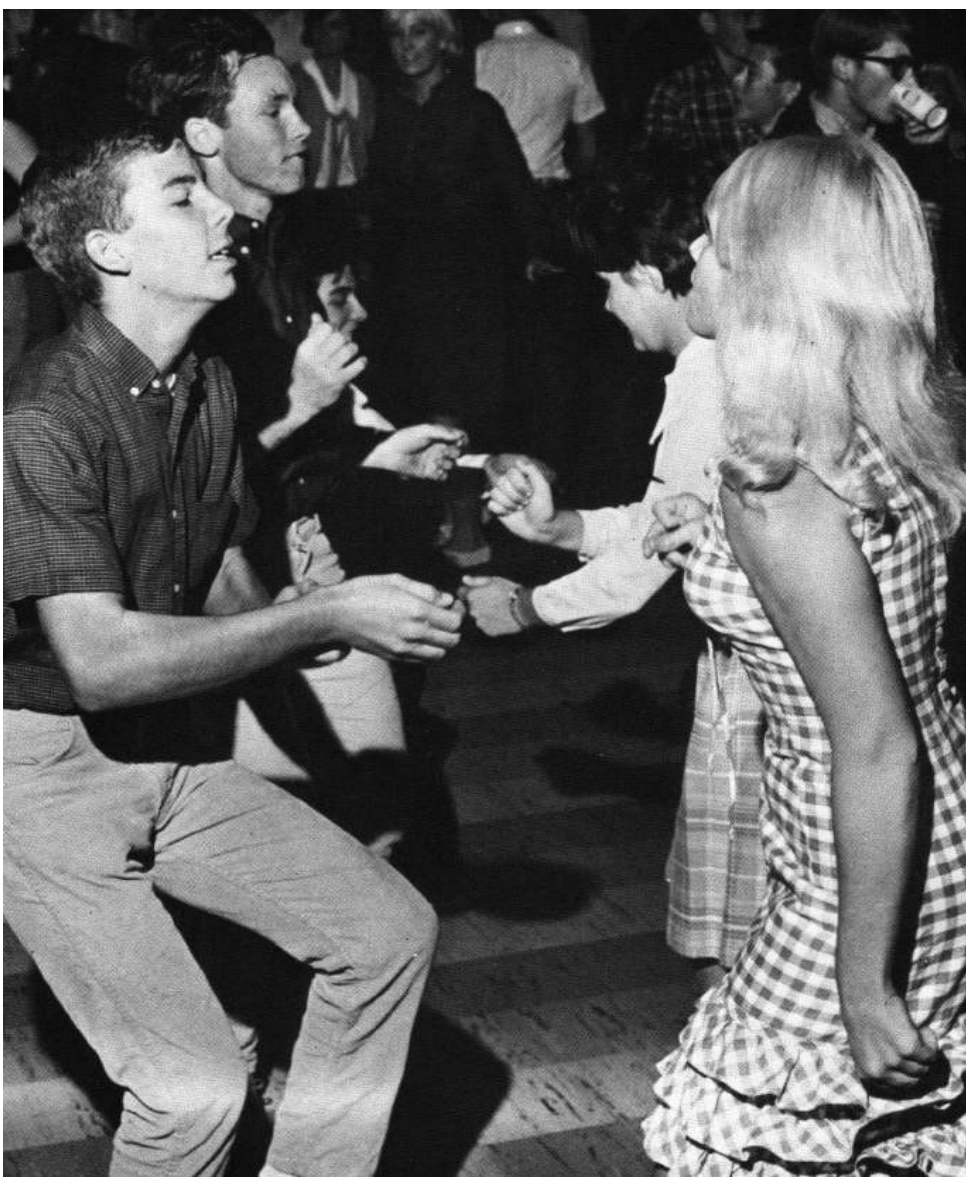


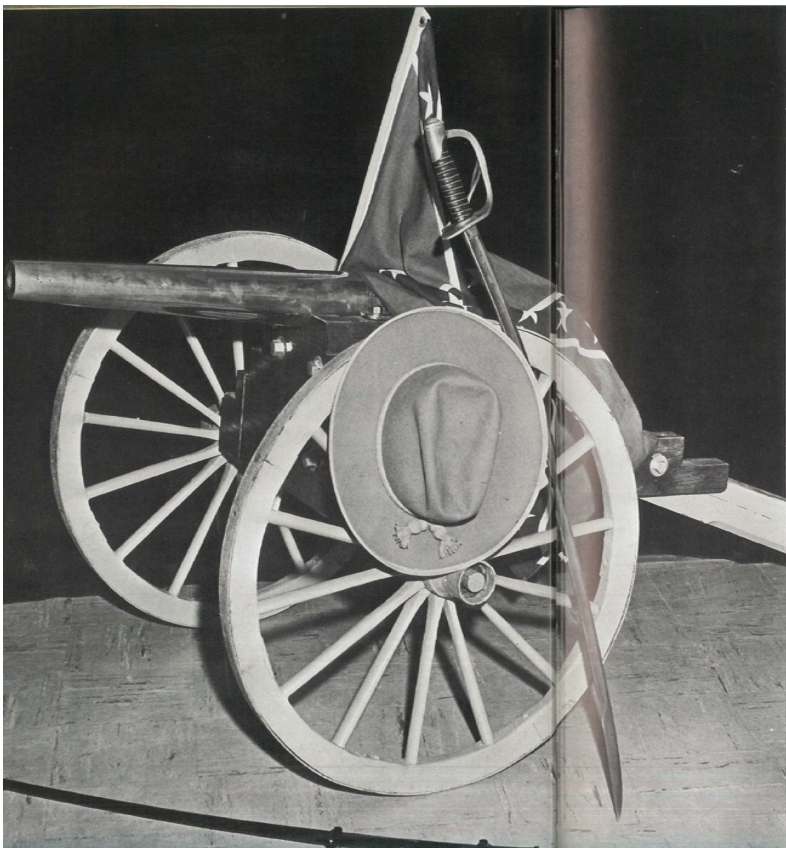












## Foreword
